**Weekly Homework**- Spelling test everyone Monday and we will go through the completed homework together using our purple pens.

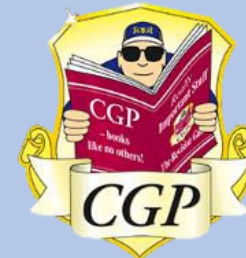
**Timestables** – Try to play Times Table Rockstars regularly through the week. You could be the Times Table Rockstars Champion of the week!
