**PE Kits**- Need to be in school every day Monday to Friday.

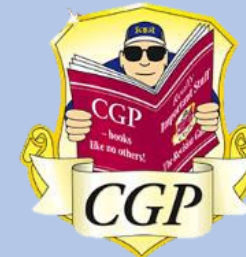
**Water Bottles**- Need to be in school every day and should contain water only.
