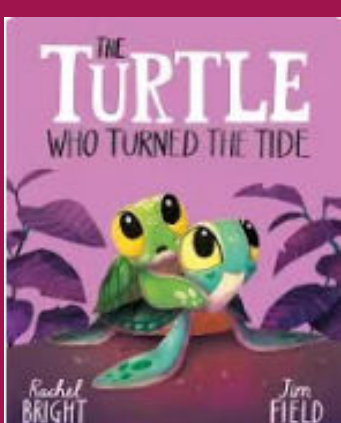

Attendance notifications sent via email cannot be accepted and will always be followed up with a telephone call to verify the absence.



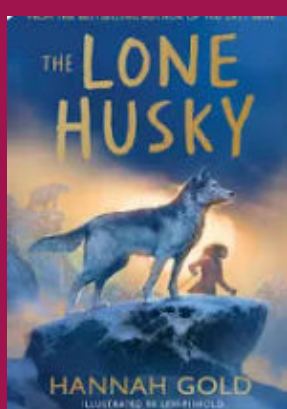

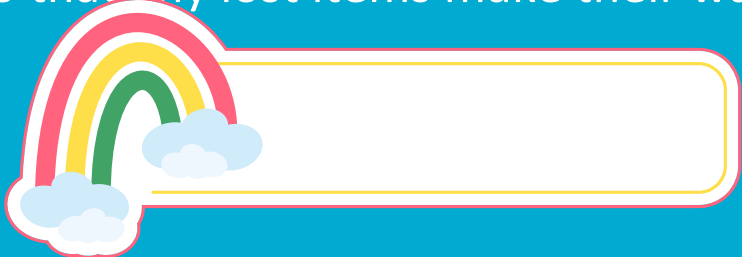


Uniform

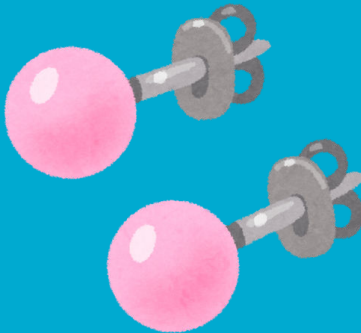
We are particularly in need of **trainers suitable for our older children**, as these are often the most difficult items to provide.

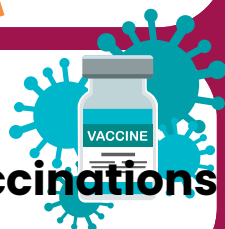
